All agreed.</p> <p>4) 23709 MATTERS ARISING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Volunteer Speed Watch Scheme – PCSO Cocks will provide a poster and requested that any volunteer interest is forwarded onto him, two names were taken. b) Overgrown Areas Burrows Barn Lane/Summerlane – Owners have been sent a letter requesting the hedges/shrubs are cut back, work is in hand. c) Road Sign North end of Village – Highways has inspected the road sign but do not consider it an immediate safety hazard and will repair when finance allows. d) Tree behind Church – The tree is inspected every three years by a professional tree specialist and in the interim is checked by trained staff in basic tree inspection. The tree was last professionally inspected in March 2019. e) Overgrown Shrubs along B3359 and front of Church – Both areas have now been attended to. f) Dog Warden Visit – The warden will visit the area to review signage. g) Pelynt Academy Garden Plots – The Academy are looking to resurrect the plots in the Spring and confirmed that the area had been returned to the school as they were no longer required by residents. h) Play Area Shrubs – Overgrown shrubs in the area have been dealt with. <p>5) 23710 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION The Police report received was read stating that during the month of August eight crimes were committed in the Parish. PCSO Cock thanked the Parish Council for their feedback regarding the Community Speed Watch project and asked for any interested volunteers to contact him. Various patrols had been undertaken throughout the Parish. A member of the public suggested that work undertaken at Budley Water would be an improvement specifically to the under surface of the ford as it was very rough and uneven. It was also suggested that this work would stop any contamination of the stream from sewerage seepage which could be</p>	

<p>harmful to residents and animals. The clerk was requested to contact Highways regarding overhanging vegetation opposite the Beacon Park turning. It was stated that measurements for the Oxford Cross Milestone post were still being awaited. Ideas to combat global warming will be added to the next agenda with a view to planting trees around the Parish. The clerk will contact Highways to request repainting of yellow lines on the corner adjacent to the Spar Shop.</p>	<p>Clerk</p>
