

PARKING POLICY

THE VILLAGE GREEN PARKING AREA

NO PUBLIC OR PRIVATE RIGHTS EXIST OVER THIS AREA

This land is owned and maintained by Pelynt Parish Council.

Policy 1a relates to the tarmac area in front of St Nun's Church:-

1. Vehicles may park by driving/reversing onto the area, vehicles must not be parked side on.
2. Owners should park responsibly to allow the maximum number of vehicles to use the area.
3. Vehicles should not remain unmoved for longer than 1 week, if there is a situation where the vehicle cannot be moved the Parish Council must be informed.
4. Camper vans and caravans are not permitted to park on the area.
5. No vehicle repair works are permitted to be undertaken on the area.
6. The area marked with yellow lining is to be kept clear at all times for use by emergency services and the incumbent Rector of the Church.
7. Members of the Parish Council and the Clerk will monitor the area and will investigate any complaints received relating to infringement of the Policy.
8. A letter informing residents of any breach to the Policy will be sent by the Clerk on behalf of the Parish Council.
9. The Parish Council reserve the right to request, by letter, that vehicles are removed permanently if vehicle owners repeatedly misuse the area.
10. The Clerk, on behalf of the Parish Council, will notify residents by letter of the annual 24 hour closure, a notice will also be posted on the Parish noticeboard, website and local Facebook page. Residents are expected to comply fully with the request to remove their vehicle for this period.

Policy 1b relates to areas of Village Green opposite St Nun's Church adjacent to 1 The Green and 1 Bullers Terrace:-

1. The areas in question are registered as Village Green.
2. No vehicles are permitted to park on the Village Green between 1 The Green and 1 Bullers Terrace.
3. The owners/tenants of 1 The Green and 2 Bullers Terrace will be given prescriptive rights from the Parish Council to permit vehicle access across the Village Green.
4. The owner of 2 Bullers Terrace has an established right to park on the tarmac area in front of his garage doors by way of twenty (20) years of unchallenged, uninterrupted use for this purpose.
5. Permission for vehicle access will be solely for owners/tenants of the above addresses and should the above properties be sold the new owner must apply to the Parish Council for prescriptive rights.
6. Permission is limited to owners/tenants and family members of the above addresses.
7. The areas registered as Village Green must be kept clear at all times including removal of any pots, planters and other items.
8. Repair of these areas, should they suffer any disturbance or deterioration relating to vehicles using the access, will be the responsibility of the owner/tenant.
9. The Parish Council reserve the right to withdraw permission for vehicle access if the area is being abused.
