Proposed Cllr S Smith. Seconded Cllr L Mattick. All agreed.</p> <p>4) 24016 MATTERS ARISING Hedge on Summerlane – The clerk reported that several letters had been sent to the resident in question stating that the hedge is the responsibility of Cormac Solutions, contact details have been supplied.</p> <p>5) 24017 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION Cllr Wakeham read the Police report stating that five crimes had been committed in the Parish during May. Data from speed radars is being awaited from Cormac and this will be shared with the Parish Council once received. The Neighbourhood Team have been attempting to create a Community Speed Watch for the area for fourteen months and are trying to recruit volunteers, anyone interested should contact PCSO Cocks on 30211@dc.police.uk . A member of the public enquired if a tree and plaque could be arranged to commemorate the Queen’s Jubilee next year, the enquiry also included planting additional trees around the Parish. The clerk was requested to investigate funding opportunities. Cllr Hannaford will report a complaint to Cormac relating to grass contractors mowing round small items at Luffman Close. A complaint was raised regarding the 30mph speed limit signs not being visible enough at the South end of the Village, it was confirmed that decisions made relating to position and size of signs was the responsibility of Highways. It was requested that the second opportunity allowing Public Participation during meetings was reinstated onto the agenda, it was noted that this had been removed while Zoom meetings were being held.</p> <p>6) 24018 CORNWALL COUNCILLOR Cllr Hannaford’s report had been circulated to members prior to the meeting. It was agreed that data from the speed cameras would be helpful to secure further speed calming measures. It was confirmed that Community Speed Watch groups cannot operate in their own Parishes. Five Council members from Polruan have signed up and could change over with Pelynt if volunteers can be found, Cllr Hannaford has</p>	Clerk

volunteered for both parishes. A meeting has been arranged with Coastline Housing on the 28th July to discuss outstanding issues on the site, Cllr Wakeham will also attend. Cllr Hannaford is in the process of co-ordinating a multi agency walkabout to discuss issues raised in Pelynt. A meeting has been arranged for the 8th July with residents living in the area by the Shute to discuss flooding issues. A Councillor Surgery will be held in the Social Club on the last Friday of every month, anyone wishing to attend is requested to pre arrange an appointment to ensure Covid regulations can be adhered to.

7) 24019 SENTRY MEADOW

The clerk reported that barriers on the pedestrian walkway were now installed, surfacing work will be undertaken at a later date. It was confirmed that the financial obligation for the VAS monitors was in the process of being transferred to the Parish Council.

8) 24020 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Cllr Mattick reported that the PNDP questionnaires were being circulated in the latest edition of the 'Eye on Pelynt' and were also available online. The initial questionnaire is to ascertain if residents want a Neighbourhood Plan if a positive result is received a more in depth questionnaire will follow. Although the time scale for completion of the plan is several years members agreed that it is encouraging to see the project progressing so quickly.

9) 24021 BURROWS BARN LANE

It was resolved not to proceed with declassifying the lane due to the financial outlay it would incur.

10) 24022 LUFFMAN CLOSE

The clerk reported that an update on removing the garages to create additional parking had been requested but to date no further details had been received.

11) 24023 SPEEDING ISSUES

SWARCO has confirmed an engineer visit has been scheduled relating to problems downloading data from the Summerlane monitor. Cllr Wakeham will post on Pelynt Whingers for Speed Watch volunteers.

12) 24024 BUDLEY WATER

Written confirmation of the discussion and suggestions made at the meeting in April been received from Mr W Glassup. The clerk confirmed that a formal complaint had been submitted to Cornwall Council relating to work undertaken on the ford.

13) 24025 WILTON TERRACE/TREGARRICK LANE JUNCTION

The Highways Manager has visited the area and does not consider remedial work is required at this time.

14) 24026 JOLLY PARK

The clerk confirmed that suspected relocation of the footpath has been reported to the Countryside Access Team. Concerns were raised by members of the public, after discussion with the landowner, relating to use of the land now it has been fenced off.
