PC Brailey-Evans has requested roads policing colleagues to patrol the area to deal with any offences this will include the No Excuses Team who tackle the fatal five on roads. A special constable will also be working with the Neighbourhood Team and a new speed gun will be used to enable full enforcement with fines. PC Brailey-Evans stated that data stats collected at this time do not support the criteria for the deployment of a Camera Van, data will be closely monitored as it is collected. It was resolved by members to apply for a 20mph limit for various areas in the Parish.
