It was decided that the Parish Council would proceed with purchasing two defibrillators as originally agreed, to remain in their ownership, for installation at Oaklands Park and the south end of the Parish. It was resolved to purchase a third unit, to remain in the ownership of the Parish Council, to be installed at an alternative site to the Social Club as this would not be the optimum location due to a unit already in place at the Village Hall.
