All agreed.</p> <p>4) 24315 MATTERS ARISING</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Highways Scheme – An Expression of Interest has been submitted requesting 40mph speed limit signs prior to the 30mph signs at the North and South ends of the village. b) Play Area Bin – A bin has been ordered and has a lead time delivery date of four weeks. c) Overhanging Foliage, Barton Meadow – The hydrangeas have been pruned away from the pavement. d) Polcoombe/Woolwashing – Owners of the site can hold events on twenty eight days per year without a licence. <p>5) 24316 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION An irate resident who lives on The Green enquired who owned the carpark in front of the church, it was confirmed that the Parish Council are the owners. He then raised a grievance on behalf of neighbours relating to letters received from the Parish Council concerning parking issues. The Chairman attempted to explain why the letters were sent informing him that the Parish Council monitor the area to deter storing/garaging of vehicles on the car park as the area is for everyone to use and not just a select few, letters are sent as and when needed. He then aggressively accused the Chairman of abusing the rules for his own purpose, these accusations were denied however, the complainant was unable to be placated and would not accept any explanations given.
