



**8) 24518 NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN**

Development Boundary – It was resolved not to progress with a development boundary for the Parish as this is a lengthy, complicated undertaking and as the NDP is only valid until 2030 it was felt this would be of little benefit.

**Proposed Cllr C Beall. Seconded Cllr M Boxall. 8 votes for. 1 against. 1 abstention.**

Principal Residency – It was resolved not to progress with principal residency policies as this only effects new builds and not existing dwellings.

**Proposed Cllr K Wakeham. Seconded Cllr A Taylor. 8 votes for. 1 against. 1 abstention.**

With the above decisions taken the NDP can now progress with a public consultation scheduled for November. Cornwall Council has not yet confirmed if a Strategic Environmental Assessment is required, additional grant funding will be applied for to cover future costs of the Plan.
